Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to agree to hold harmless and RE: indemnify the Hendrick Hudson School District, owner of a polling place to be used by the County in connection with the upcoming primary, general and special elections in 2023

The County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Board of Elections ("Board of Elections"), uses many non-County owned facilities (such as schools, houses of worship and municipal buildings) as polling places in order to conduct Primary, Special and General Elections. The Board of Elections has advised that the Hendrick Hudson School District, the owner of the Blue Mountain School ("Hendrick Hudson"), has requested that the County agree to indemnify them, in writing, for any damage and/or injury that may result from the County's usage of their property as a polling place in connection with the upcoming primary, special and general elections in 2022.

If authorized by your Honorable Board, the attached resolution would authorize the County to agree as follows:

"The County of Westchester hereby agrees to defend, indemnify and save harmless the Hendrick Hudson School District from and against any and all liability, loss, damages, claims for bodily injury and or property damages, cost and expense including counsel fees, to the extent permissible by law, arising out of the use of the Blue Mountain School by the above named organization, its agents, servants, employees and or its students."

The public purpose, as well as the goal and objective of this resolution, is to allow the Board of Elections to carry out its statutory duties in connection with all upcoming 2022 elections and to ensure that polling places are available to enable all eligible County residents to exercise their right to vote.
