- DND SCULIN', SECRETARY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER TO ENTER Re: INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES TO ACCEPT A GRANTIN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500,175.00 IN STATE FUNDS FOR THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE TO OPERATE THE AID TO PROSECUTION PROGRAM, FOR THE PERIOD FROM APRIL 1, 2022 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2023, PURSUANT TO AN APPROVED BUDGET.

Authority is sought for the County of Westchester ("County"), acting by and through the Office of the District Attorney ("District Attorney's Office"), to enter into an grant agreement (the "Grant Agreement") with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services ("DCJS") to accept a grant in an amount not to exceed \$500,175.00 in State Funds for the District Attorney's Office to operate the Ais to Prosecution Program (the "Program"), for the period from April 1, 2022 through March 32, 2023, pursuant to an approved budget.

The goals and exjectives of the Program are to enhance the prosecution of repeated, violent and serious felony offenders by maintaining increased levels of experienced prosecution personnel and to reduce crime through investigations and enhanced vertical prosecution by targeting violent and non-violent felony crimes. These goals and objectives will promote the general welfare and public safety of the citizens of the Westchester County by expediting the arrest and prosecution of felony offenders charged with violent felony offenses, persistent felony offenders charged with non violent felony offenses and other serious felony offenders helping make the County a safer place. The goals and objectives of the Program will be tracked and monitored by the District Attorney's Office through quarterly reports that will be submitted to DCJS for their review and approval.

As the Grant Agreement does not constitute a procurement of goods or services, it is not subject to the provisions of the County Procurement Policy.
