On December 17, 2025, the County of Westchester ("County") received and opened two (2) bids for Contract No. 25-513 for Boiler and Burner Control Upgrades – Phase I, Grasslands Campus, Valhalla, New York.

Two (2) contractors submitted a bid for this project. The project was advertised on the Empire State Purchasing Group website, in addition to the Journal News (Westchester-Putnam Edition), and was viewed by ninety-six (96) entities on the Empire State Purchasing Group website. In addition, emails were sent to those ninety-six (96) entities and to an additional one thousand one hundred and twenty-seven (1,127) suppliers and contractors.

The bids were reviewed by the Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department") and it was determined that Miller Proctor Nickolas, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$2,145,121.06.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Miller Proctor Nickolas, Inc.:
