RE: Authority for the County of Westchester to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the United States Capitol Police, whereby the County will provide law enforcement services, as requested, to support the Capital Police for Congressional events and/or protective operations occurring within the County's jurisdiction, with the Capital Police reimbursing the County for costs associated with providing such services, for a term commencing upon execution of the Memorandum by both parties and continuing indefinitely unless terminated by either party on thirty (30) days written notice.

Attached for your consideration is a Resolution, which, if approved by your Honorable Board, would authorize the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Public Safety (the "Department"), to enter into a memorandum of understanding (the "MOU") with the United States Capitol Police (the "USCP"), whereby the County will provide law enforcement services, as requested, to support the USCP for Congressional events and/or protective operations occurring within the County's jurisdiction (the "Services"), for a term commencing upon execution of the MOU by both parties and continuing indefinitely unless terminated by either party on thirty (30) days written notice. In consideration for the County's provision of Services pursuant to the MOU, the USCP will reimburse the County for costs incurred in connection with the performance thereof, payable upon the County's submission of an invoice to USCP.

Pursuant to 2 U.S. Code § 1966, the USCP is authorized to protect, in any area of the United States, the person of any Member of Congress or officer of the Congress, as those terms are defined therein, as well as any member of the immediate family of any Member or officer, if the Capitol Police Board determines such protection is necessary. In order to fulfill this responsibility, the USCP has determined that it is necessary to augment their capabilities by having the County provide, upon request, law enforcement support to the USCP for Congressional events and/or USCP protective operations taking place within Westchester County, and the County desires to provide such support.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, it should be noted that the provision of Services by the County under this MOU shall be subject to, and contingent upon, the receipt of a request from the USCP and the County's agreement to such request, based on the availability of resources.

The goals and objectives of the proposed MOU is to assist the USCP in protecting the members of Congress during Congressional Events and/or protective operations occurring in the County's jurisdiction.

Since the proposed MOU does not constitute a procurement of goods or services, it is not subject to the provisions of the Westchester County Procurement Policy.

Accordingly, your favorable action on the annexed Resolution is most respectfully urged and recommended.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner-Sheriff of the Department of Public Safety, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (the “County”), acting by and through its Department of Public Safety (the “Department”), is hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (the “MOU”) with the United States Capital Police (the “USCP”), whereby the County shall provide law enforcement services, as requested, to support the USCP for Congressional events and/or protective operations occurring within the County’s jurisdiction (the “Services”), for a term commencing upon execution of the MOU by both parties and continuing indefinitely unless terminated by either party on thirty (30) days written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that in consideration for the County’s provision of Services pursuant to the MOU, the USCP shall reimburse the County for costs incurred in connection with the performance thereof, payable upon the County’s submission of an invoice to the USCP; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents and take all actions reasonably necessary and appropriate to effectuate the purposes of this resolution.
