The attached resolution, if approved by your Honorable Board, would authorize the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into grant agreements with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to accept Fiscal Year 2025 funds totaling approximately Six Million, Sixty-three Thousand Three hundred sixtythree Dollars and eight cents \$6,063,363.08) under the following programs:

Act #2025 101, adopted May 19, 2025 by the Westchester County Board of Legislators. authorizes the County to submit to HUD an amendment to the 2024-2028 Consolidated Plancon behalf of the Urban County Consortium for to include the Fiscal Year 2025 Armual Action Plan Federal Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Fartnership Program and Emergency Solution Grant Program and submit the Fiscal Year 2025 Action Plan to accept said grant funds.

The County of Westchester wishes to receive these non-repayable federal funds on behalf of the 31 participating municipalities in the Urban County Consortium to complete a range of activities through the Community Development Block Grant, HOME Investment Partnership Program and Emergency Solutions Grant; all programs benefit low and very low-income households. Fiscal Year 2025 begins May 1, 2025 and ends April 30, 2026.

These funds will be monitored by Westchester County Department of Planning staff who will make site visits, review all grant applications, award only viable programs/projects in low/moderate Consortium Communities and provide follow-up review for all awards for adherence to contract specifications.
