On July 30, 2025, the County of Westchester ("County") received and opened eleven (11) bids for Contract No. 25-511 for New Roofing Membrane and Repairs, Woodfield Detention Facility, 20 Hammond House Road, Valhalla, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department") and it was determined that Nua Construction Corp. (WBE) submitted the low bid in the amount of \$606,000.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Nua Construction Corp. (WBE):
