The 2025 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work included in this project consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to mitigate further erosion of the shoreline and to protect the existing process tanks, the shoreline requires rehabilitation/replacement to restore the revetment to the proper slope with the proper gradation/layers of stone.

The objective of this project is to rehabilitate the erosion damage at the base of the secondary clarifiers and chlorine contact tanks near the Hudson River at the Ossining Water Resource Recovery Facility.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it ensures that the facility meets ongoing operational needs and complies with current building codes and environmental codes.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
