1 Budget The 2025 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to rehabilitate the primary sludge gravity thickener collection equipment, including but not limited to the piping and valves; the installation of new primary sludge bar screens; and/or the replacement of the existing influent bar screens. The work will also include all mechanical, structural, architectural, electrical, instrumentation, controls, HVAC, and plumbing work and appurtenances as required.

In accordance with Chapter 635 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this contract is to keep its water and wastewater treatment equipment in a state of good repair, in accordance with State and Federal regulations. The processing and removal of solids is critical we meeting the facility's State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("SPDES") Permit. Performing this work will allow the Department to maintain its critical infrastructure and provide for the health and welfare of its employees and the residents of the County.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it ensures that the facility meets ongoing operational needs and complies with current building codes.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
