Slope Stabilization of North Yonkers Trunk Sewer

Yonkers Joint Plant Districts

Dobbs Ferry, Hastings, and Yonkers, New York

The 2025 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to rehabilitate the North Yonkers Trunk Sewer, including but not limited to, stabilization of the existing earthen slopes where the trunk sewer is buried. In the past, erosive storm water flows off the steep slopes have exposed the sewer pipe and uprooted trees uphill of the trunk sewer undermining, exposing and damaging the sewer, resulting in the release of raw sewage to the surrounding areas. In order to prevent future damage, stabilizing measures such as minor tree removal, small retaining walls and granular fill over the exposed pipes within the existing Right-of-Way will be implemented to help mitigate future exposure and undermining of the pipes.

The objective of this project will be the rehabilitation and stabilization of the earthen slopes covering the North Yonkers Trunk Sewer as required under the Capacity Assurance, Management, Operation and Maintenance (CMOM) Program to insure the environmentally compliant operation of the County's sewage collection system. The Program requires the existing trunk sewer be inspected periodically and any deficiencies corrected in order to prevent unnecessary damage to the collection system, as well as the surrounding environment.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it effectuates long-term maintenance and repairs as required by the CMOM Program for this section of trunk sewer avoiding potential adverse environmental impact to the surrounding properties and the Hudson River, thereby promoting public health policies and laws.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further
