RE: Authority to rescind the resolution approved on May 28, 2026 authorizing the County to enter into a license agreement with Nicholas & Lence Communications for use of certain areas at Glen Island Park for the purpose of holding an event known as The Lantern Festival from August 24, 2026 through November 10, 2026, which includes dates for set up and break down and to approve a new resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to enter into a license agreement with Kaleido Arts & Entertainment Group LLC as Nicholas & Lence is the PR firm and Kaleido Arts & Entertainment Group LLC is the actual operating entity for the festival and will be the party signing the paperwork.

On May 28, 2026, your Honorable Board approved a resolution (OnBase ID 113742) authorizing the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation (the "Department") to enter into a license agreement with Nicholas & Lence Communications for use of certain areas at Glen Island Park for the purpose of holding an event known as The Lantern Festival from August 24, 2026 through November 10, 2026, which includes dates for set up and break down (the "May 28, 2026 Resolution").

However, subsequent to your Honorable Board's approval of the May 28, 2026 Resolution, the Department was advised that that entity is the PR firm and the actual entity operating the festival is Kaleido Arts & Entertainment Group LLC.

Therefore, authority is hereby requested from your Honorable Board to rescind the May 28, 2026 Resolution and to instead authorize the County to enter into a license agreement with Kaleido Arts & Entertainment Group LLC for the use of certain areas at Glen Island Park for the purpose of holding an event known as The Lantern Festival from August 24, 2026 through November 10, 2026, which includes dates for set up and break down. There will be no cost to the County.

Except as specifically amended hereby, all remaining terms and conditions set forth in the Prior Resolution shall remain the same.

A resolution requesting authorization to amend the Prior Resolution is attached for your approval.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Conservation, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the resolution approved on May 28, 2026 (On-Base ID No. 113742) is hereby rescinded in its entirety; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (the "County") is hereby authorized to enter into a license agreement with Kaleido Arts & Entertainment Group LLC for the for use of certain areas at Glen Island Park for the purpose of holding an event known as The Lantern Festival from August 24, 2026 through November 10, 2026, which includes dates for set up and break down; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby empowered to execute any and all instruments and take such other actions as may reasonably be necessary to effectuate the purposes thereof.
