RE: **Authority for the County of Westchester to enter into a Grant Agreement
with the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") for \$5,439,000 in
Federal Transit Capital Assistance (Grant Agreement NY 2025-013)**

Authority is requested for the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into an agreement with the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") to accept **\$5,439,000** in Federal Transit Capital Assistance. In addition, a 20% County match is required in order for the County to receive the FTA funds, for a total funding amount of **\$6,798,750**. The funding sources are broken down as follows:

Funds received from this grant will be utilized as follows:

Transfer of FHWA's STBG Funds to the Section 5307 Program - Purchase 40' Replacement Buses (\$5,439,000 Federal)

Funds will be used to Westchester County is requesting federal assistance in the amount of \$5,439,000, STBG flexed 5307 funds. The total project cost is \$6,798,750.00, with the county providing a 20% local match of \$1,359,750. The STBG flexed funds in this grant will go toward the procurement of up to 95 Hybrid Diesel-Electric and/or all electric 40-foot replacement buses, related equipment, vehicle repair spare parts, vehicle inspection tools and vehicle specification review. The current 2009 buses have a useful life of 12 years and 500,000 miles and were eligible for replacement in 2021. The new buses will also have a useful life of 12 years and 500,000 miles. The list of buses being replaced with the required information is attached to the grant.

The receipt of federal funds will be monitored by both the Department of Public Works and Transportation and the Department of Finance.

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation, be it hereby:

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (the "County") is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) for \$6,798,750 (Federal \$5,439,000/80% and Local \$1,359,750/20%) to fund the replacement of Forty-Foot diesel coaches with up to 95 Forty-Foot Hybrid Diesel-Electric buses, associated services, specification preparation, review, inspection, training, tools and parts for the Bee Line bus system; and be it further

Department of Transportation effectuating the purpose of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and to set forth and execute affirmative minority business policies in connection with the project; and be it further
