Re: Authority for the County of Westchester, acting by and through Westchester Community College's Educational Opportunity Center, to enter into an agreement with the City of Yonkers, acting by and through its Police Department, for the services of Police Officers during the graduation of students from the Westchester Educational Opportunity Center on June 11, 2026, at a total cost not to exceed One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven (\$1,937.00) Dollars.

Westchester Community College (the "College"), on behalf of the Westchester Educational Opportunity Center ("WEOC"), desires to enter into an agreement with the City of Yonkers, acting by and through its Police Department ("Yonkers"), for the provision of police officers during the WEOC's graduation ceremonies at the Roosevelt High School on June 11, 2026.

Authority is hereby requested for the County of Westchester, acting by and through the Westchester Community College ("College"), to enter into an agreement with Yonkers for the provision of police officers during the WEOC's graduation ceremonies (the "Service") at the Roosevelt High School on June 11, 2026. In consideration for the provision of these services, the College will pay Yonkers an amount not to exceed One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven (\$1,937.00) Dollars.

In accordance with the terms of the agreement, the College shall agree, in a form similar to the following: for itself and its successors and assigns hereby release, discharge, indemnify, defend and hold the City of Yonkers, the Yonkers Police Department, and the City's officers, agents, servants, employees, elected and appointed officials, successors, and assigns harmless from any and all claims, damages, demands, suits, actions or liability of any nature whatsoever, including reasonable attorney's fees and, including but not limited to, damages to persons or property directly arising from the activities of the College.

I recommend that you act favorably on the annexed proposed resolution.

Upon a communication from the President of Westchester Community College, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester, acting by and through Westchester Community College (the "College"), on behalf of the Westchester Educational Opportunity Center ("WEOC"), is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Yonkers, acting by and through its Police Department ("Yonkers") for the provision of police officers during the WEOC's graduation ceremonies at the Roosevelt High School on June 11, 2026; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the cost to utilize the Roosevelt High School shall not exceed One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Seven (\$1,937.00) Dollars; and be it further

RESOLVED, that in accordance with the terms of the Agreement the College shall, in a form similar to the following: for itself and its successors and assigns hereby release, discharge, indemnify, defend and hold the City of Yonkers, the Yonkers Police Department, and the City's officers, agents, servants, employees, elected and appointed officials, successors, and assigns harmless from any and all claims, damages, demands, suits, actions or liability of any nature whatsoever, including reasonable attorney's fees and, including but not limited to, damages to persons or property, directly arising from the activities of the College; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee be and hereby is authorized and empowered to execute any and all instruments and to take all action necessary to implement the purposes hereof.
