Bet Resolution Authorizing an Agreement Between the County of Westchester SUBJECT:

and the Village/Town of Mount Kisco for a streetscape project on Maple

Avenue in the Village/Town.

The attached resolution, if approved by your Honorable Board, would authorize the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into an agreement with the Village/Town of Mount Kisco (the "Village/Town"), pursuant to which the Village/Town will install approximately 1020 linear feet of 8 inch diameter class 54 ductile iron pipe watermain (the "Project") on Maple Avenue. In consideration for performing the Project, the County will pay the Village/Town an amount not to exceed \$200,000, in Community Development Block Grant funding, pursuant to an approved budget. The agreement will commence on July 102024 and continue through June 30, 2025.

The Project incitides the installation of approximately 102 linear feet of 8 inch diameter class 54 ductile iron pipe on Maple Avenue in Mount Kisco, which has experienced four breaks in as many years. The pipe is undersized and has exceeded its useful life.

The goal and objective of the Project is to provide a reliable and consistent source of water to the residents of the Village/Town The Project will be monitored by the Milage/Towns' Public Works Department and the Westchester County Department of Planning staff who will make site visits to ensure all contractual requirements are met.

This procurement is in compliance with the County of Westchester Procurement Policy Procedures, pursuant to Section 3(a)xvi, which exempts contracts with recipients for disbursement of grants or loans under the Community Development Block Grant Program.

Act # 56-2023, adopted May 4, 2023, by the Westchester County Board of Legislators, authorizes the County to submit an Urban County Application under the Federal

Community Development Block Grant, Emergency Solutions Grant, and HOME Investment Programs, amending the FY 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan to include the FY 2023 Action Plan.
