RE: Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to enter into a grant agreement (NYS

Contract No. C005394) with the State of New York to accept funding to implement the Vote By Mail Grant in the amount of \$264,057.55 for the term April 1, 2025 to March 31,

2026.

Authority is requested for the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Board of Elections (the "BOE"), to enter into a grant agreement with the State of New York (NYS Contract No. C005394) to accept Vote By Mail Grant funding in the amount of \$264,057.55, payable on a reimbursement basis, for the term commencing on April 1, 2025 and terminating on March 31, 2026.

The State of New York, acting by and through the New York State Board of Elections has allocated to Westchester County these funds which are to be utilized to reimburse for costs related to providing pre-paid return postage and outgoing postage on absentee ballots and applications, and Early Mail Voting ballots and applications, for elections to be held in 2025.

The public purpose of the proposed agreement is to facilitate the purchase of necessary expenses related to the postage for absentee ballots and applications and Early Voting Mail Voting Ballots and applications.

The County is also seeking authority to indemnify the State of New York as follows:

Indemnification: The Contractor shall be solely responsible and answerable in damages for all accidents, incidents, and/or injuries to persons (including death) or property arising out of or related to the services to be rendered by the Contractor or its subcontractors pursuant to this Contract. The Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the State and its officers and

employees from claims, suits, actions, damages, and cost of every nature arising out of the provision of services pursuant to the Contract.

We certify that the BOE: a) has copies of, or access to, all applicable laws, rules, regulations, grant applications and grant agreements (including any master grant agreement), as well as any guidance or instructions received from the agency making the grant (the "Grant Terms"), b) has reviewed the Grant Terms, c) is aware of and understands all of the Grant Terms, and d) can and will comply with all of the Grant Terms.

In order to take advantage of these grant funds and to enter into the grant extension agreement your approval of the annexed proposed resolution is requested.
