ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES TO ACCEPT A GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000.00 IN STATE FUNDS FOR THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE TO OPERATE THE ILLEGAL FENTANYL PROSECUTION PROGRAM FOR THE PERIOD FROM APRIL 1, 2024

THROUGH MARCH 31, 2025.

Authority is sought for the County of Westchester ("County"), acting by and through the Office of the District Attorney ("District Attorney's Office"), to enter into a grant agreement (the "Grant Agreement") with the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services ("DCJS") to accept a grant in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 in State Funds for the District Attorney's Office to operate the Illegal Fentanyl Prosecution Program (the "Program"), for the period from April 1, 2024 through March 31, 2025.

The goals and objectives of the Program is to assist local law enforcement efforts to disrupt the supply of illegal fentanyl chains flowing into the community. The Program will allow prosecutors to target those chains and prosecute cases involving overdose deaths. The Program is to support the costs of personnel, training, technology and equipment to advance opioid-based prosecution. These goals and objectives will promote the general welfare and public safety of the citizens of the Westchester County by enhancing the prosecution and investigative efforts of combatting and tracking the latest opioid distribution trends. The goals and objectives of the Program will be tracked and monitored by the District Attorney's Office through quarterly reports that will be submitted to DCJS for their review and approval.

As the Grant Agreement does not constitute a procurement of goods or services, it is not subject to the provisions of the County Procurement Policy.
