SUBJECT: Request for authority for the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with Sun River Health, Inc., pursuant to which Sun River Health, Inc. will conduct outreach to re-engage its uninsured and underinsured patients as well as outreach to new clients without a current medical home, to provide primary medical / dental care and preventive health services with targeted outreach to women ages 18-44 for linkage to preventive care, for the period from June 1, 2026 and continuing through December 31, 2026, for an amount not to exceed \$100,000 payable quarterly in accordance with an approved budget.

Authority is respectfully requested for the County of Westchester (“County”) to enter into an agreement with Sun River Health, Inc. (“SRH”) pursuant to which SRH will conduct outreach to re-engage its uninsured and underinsured patients as well as outreach to new clients without a current medical home, to provide primary medical / dental care and preventive health services with targeted outreach to women ages 18-44 for linkage to preventive care, for the period from June 1, 2026 and continuing through December 31, 2026, for an amount not to exceed \$100,000 payable quarterly in accordance with an approved budget (the “Agreement”).

The proposed Agreement will serve a public purpose by providing the above described health services to vulnerable uninsured and underinsured patients and new clients to ensure healthier communities through re-engagement of care and fact-based health education in a safe environment.

The goals and objectives of the Agreement are to re-engage existing patients and new clients to primary medical/dental and preventive care services in order to positively impact the most critical New York State Prevention Agenda goals as identified by the County. The expected outcome is to improve the overall health and welfare of these patients lost during the pandemic and for new clients without a medical home.

This Agreement will be tracked and monitored by the Health Department by reviewing summary reports of patient care visit metrics by category, staff time involved and expenses for all services provided.

This Agreement is exempt from the requirements of the County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3(a)(viii) thereof.

Accordingly, I most respectfully recommend approval of the attached Resolution.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of the Westchester County Department of Health, be it hereby:

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (“County”) is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Sun River Health, Inc. (“SRH”), pursuant to which SRH will conduct outreach to re-engage its uninsured and underinsured patients as well as outreach to new clients without a current medical home, to provide primary medical / dental care and preventive health services with targeted outreach to women ages 18-44 for linkage to preventive care, for the period from June 1, 2026 and continuing through December 31, 2026, for an amount not to exceed \$100,000 payable quarterly in accordance with an approved budget (the “Agreement”); and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the “State Budget”) proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed State Budget and/or the adoption of a State Budget or any amendments thereto, and for a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of any such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then the Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive, or his duly authorized designee, is hereby authorized to execute any documents and take any actions reasonably necessary and appropriate to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.
