on Schiky secretiary Hastings Pumping Station Influent Sewer Rehabilitation

North Yonkers Sanitary Sewer District Village of Hastings-on-Hudson, New York

The 2025 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required to rehabilitate the Hastings Pumping Station Influent Sewer in the Village of Hastings-On-Hudson, New York. The Hastings Pumping Station Influent Sewer is a 12-inch cast iron gravity sewer approximately 2,300-feet long with 19 manholes which serviced the former Anaconda Wire property, which is now a NYSDEC Superfund site. All above grade structures on the Anaconda Wire property have been demolished and the property is planned to undergo redevelopment. There is one active connection from the Village's Washington Street gravity line, across the Metro-North railroad tracks. Along the sewer there are also inactive laterals which discharge into it. This contributes to inflow and infiltration in the sewer pipe and to the Hastings Pumping Station. The rehabilitation will consist of a cured-in-place liner installation and manhole rehabilitation to restore the pipe integrity, mitigate inflow and infiltration, and prepare the sewer to accept flow from the redevelopment of the property. The line will be CCTV'd to identify required pre-lining steps, such as joint separation, joint grouting, debris removal, as well as to identify areas requiring heavy cleaning with high-pressure hydraulic jetting or the use of a metal/steel blade type pig, due to heavy build-up, prior to cured-in-place liner installation.

The objective of this contract is to prevent failure, including the occurrence of a sewage overflow emergency that could allow sewage into the surrounding properties and cause violations of the pumping station's State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("SPDES") Permit. This contract will benefit the public as it will ensure that the wastewater collection system operations are safe and environmentally compliant, thereby enhancing the health and general welfare of the residents of Westchester County.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it ensures that the facility meets ongoing operational needs and complies with current building codes.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further
