SUBJECT: Authority for the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with Zamperla, Inc to perform work, which includes winterizing, inspecting, repairing, replacing and maintaining certain rides at Playland Park and procuring necessary supplies and parts for a term commencing October 14, 2025 and continuing through May 31, 2026, in an amount not to exceed \$1,992,423.42 pursuant to an approved budget.

Attached for your consideration is a resolution, which, if approved by your Honorable Board, would authorize the County of Westchester ("County") to enter into an agreement with Zamperla, Inc. ("Zamperla") to (i) perform Ride Maintenance Support, which includes ride winterizing, ride parts and spare parts for certain rides at Playland Park for the period October 14, 2025 through December 31, 2025 in an amount not to exceed \$1,050,343.42, and (ii) Ride Maintenance Support for certain rides at Playland Park for the period March 2, 2026 through May 31, 2026 in an amount not to exceed \$942,080.00, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,992,423.42, pursuant to an approved budget and subject to appropriations ("Agreement"). The Agreement term will commence October 14, 2025 and continue through May 31, 2026.

As you will recall in order to open the iconic Playland Amusement Park for a portion of the 2025 operating season, the County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation ("Department") declared an emergency situation and selected Zamperla to perform the necessary emergency work, which included inspecting, repairing, replacing and maintaining specific rides and procuring necessary supplies and parts. The County owns 11 rides that were manufactured by Zamperla and a number of other rides manufactured by a company that is no longer in business. Zamperla not only has familiarity with the rides but also has the expertise and ability to provide the parts and maintenance. That agreement was successfully concluded in September.

The County now seeks to continue its relationship with Zamperla and the Department has determined after reasonable investigation, that there is only one practicable source, Zamperla, for the provision of the above described services.

As I believe this Agreement to be in the best interests of the County, I most respectfully urge your Honorable Board to approve the attached resolution.

RESOLUTION

Upon a communication from the Commissioner of the Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (the “County”) is authorized to enter into an agreement with Zamperla, Inc. to (i) perform Ride Maintenance Support, which includes ride winterizing, ride parts and spare parts for certain rides at Playland Park for the period October 14, 2025 through December 31, 2025 in an amount not to exceed \$1,050,343.42, and (ii) Ride Maintenance Support for certain rides at Playland Park for the period March 2, 2026 through May 31, 2026 in an amount not to exceed \$942,080.00, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$1,992,423.42, pursuant to an approved budget (“Agreement”). The Agreement term will commence October 14, 2025 and continue through May 31, 2026; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is subject to County appropriations; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this Agreement is also subject to further financial analysis of the impact of any New York State Budget (the “State Budget”) proposed and adopted during the term of this Agreement. The County shall retain the right, upon the occurrence of any release by the Governor of a proposed budget of the State of New York and/or the adoption of the State Budget or any amendments thereto, and after the County has a reasonable period of time after such release(s) or adoption(s), to conduct an analysis of the impacts of such State Budget on County finances. After such analysis, the County shall retain the right to either terminate this Agreement or to renegotiate the amounts and rates approved herein. If the County subsequently offers to pay a reduced amount to the Contractor, then such Contractor shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon reasonable prior written notice; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized to execute any and all instruments and take all actions necessary to accomplish the purpose hereof.
