Authority is respectfully requested from your Honorable Board for the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into a grant agreement (DSS3017-26) with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"), and thereby accept a grant, for the period from March 1, 2026 through February 28, 2027, in an amount not-to-exceed \$696,933.00, being made available to the County to pay for a 'Continuum of Care' program concerning 'Coordinated Entry' data (the "Grant Agreement": NY1050L2T042510).
