Re: Request for Authorization to Settle the Lawsuit of Shean Bennett against Westchester
County; Children's Home of Poughkeepsie; and Does 1-10 in the amount of \$149,999.99.

Attached for your consideration is a resolution which, if approved by your Honorable Board, would authorize settlement of the lawsuit of Shean Bennett against Westchester
County; Children's Home of Poughkeepsie; and Does 1-10 in the amount of \$149,999.99.

On or about July 27, 2021, Shean Bennett ("Plaintiff") commenced a revival action in the Supreme Court, Westchester County against Westchester County, Children's Home of Poughkeepsie, and Does 1-10 under the New York State Child Victims Act pursuant to CPLR § 214-g for personal injuries sustained in or about 1986 or 1987. Plaintiff, a foster child, was placed by Westchester County Department of Social Services into Children's Home of Poughkeepsie, a residential foster care facility. Plaintiff alleges that he was sexually abused by a female employee of Poughkeepsie Children's Home. He alleges that he was about 10 years old at the time of the sexual abuse and that the abuse was about 5 incidents that culminated in sexual intercourse.

The County made a motion for summary judgment and argued that the Plaintiff could not prove that the County had a special duty to the Plaintiff, the County had no notice of the sexual acts or propensity of the abuser, the County is not vicariously liable for the acts of Children's Home of Poughkeepsie employees, and the County did not have day-to-day oversight and supervision of the facility. The County's motion was denied.

In light of the nature of these allegations and the likelihood that a jury may find that the County was negligent in failing to adequately supervise the Plaintiff while he was placed at Poughkeepsie Children's Home, a settlement in the total amount of \$750,000.00 is recommended with the County contributing \$149,999.99, inclusive of counsel fees.

Plaintiff is represented by Ameer Benno, Esq. of Herman Law, 475 5th Avenue, 11th Floor, New York, New York 10017. The co-defendant was represented by Andrew Schwab of Schwab Gasparini, 222 Bloomingdale Road, Suite 200, White Plains, New York 10605.
