SUBJECT: Authority to enter into an agreement with the United States of America, acting

through the Federal Aviation Administration, to accept an infrastructure

Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) Grant, Grant No. 3-36-0123-142-2025, in order to fund the development of an Airport Pavement Management Program and conduct

a pavement condition assessment at the Westchester County Airport.

Authority is respectfully requested for the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Public Works and Transportation, to enter into an agreement with the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA"), to accept an Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act ("IIJA") Grant, Grant No. 3-36-0123-142-2025.

The purpose of this grant is to fund the development of an Airport Pavement Management Program and to conduct a comprehensive pavement condition assessment at the Westchester County Airport. The total estimated cost of the project is \$230,000. The FAA will fund 90% of this amount through the IIJA Grant, and the County's 10% local share will be funded through the Airport Special Revenue Fund.

This project is part of the FAA's Airport Capital Improvement Program, which provides entitlement-based funding linked to commercial passenger enplanements. The program supports infrastructure projects that ensure operational safety and compliance with federal aviation regulations. The evaluation and management of airfield pavement conditions are essential to maintaining safe aircraft movement areas and preserving critical infrastructure.

The objective of this agreement is to assess current pavement conditions and develop a structured management program to guide future rehabilitation and repair efforts. This proactive approach will improve budget forecasting, extend pavement life cycles, determine pavement load capacities, and allow the County to maximize the use of its federal entitlement funding while supporting the long-term planning and operation of the Airport.

**RESOLVED,** that the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Public Works and Transportation, is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA"), to accept an Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act ("IIJA") Grant, Grant No. 3-36-0123-142-2025; and be it further

**RESOLVED,** that the purpose of said Grant is to fund the development of an Airport Pavement Management Program and to conduct a pavement condition assessment at the Westchester County Airport; and be it further

**RESOLVED,** that the total estimated cost of the project is \$230,000, of which 90%, not to exceed \$207,000, will be funded by the FAA through the AIP Grant, and the remaining 10%, estimated at \$23,000 will be funded by the County through the Airport Special Revenue Fund; and be it further

**RESOLVED,** that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is authorized to execute any instruments and to take any actions reasonably necessary to implement this Resolution.
