On September 10, 2025, the County of Westchester ("County") received and opened three (3) bids for Contract No. 15-551 for Electrical and HVAC Equipment Upgrades and Roof Replacement, Port Chester Wastewater Treatment Plant, Port Chester, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department") and it was determined that Mace Contracting Corporation (MBE) submitted the low bid in the amount of \$55,400,000.00. Mace Contracting Corporation (MBE) has proposed the use of the following subcontractor: D&M Electrical Contracting, Inc. (Electrical), 90 South Central Avenue, Elmsford, New York 10523.

The objective of this contract is to upgrade the electrical system of the plant, most of which was installed in 1987, because the typical life span of electrical distribution equipment is about 20 to 30 years and as such the system has reached the end of its useful life. The heating, ventilating and air conditioning (HVAC) systems and odor control system ductwork at the Port Chester WWTP, as well as, the Admin. And Sludge Processing Building roofs are all also approaching the end of their useful life. All these important systems and components should be replaced or upgraded in order to maintain reliability, safety and ease of maintenance.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it ensures that the facility meets ongoing operational needs and complies with current building codes.

The Department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 15-551 be awarded to Mace Contracting Corporation (MBE) in the amount of \$55,400,000.00.
