Re:             Resolution to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures, pursuant to Sec. 3(a)xxi thereof, the procurement of an amendment to an agreement between the County of Westchester and Barton and Loguidice, D.P.C. for floodplain management planning.

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Authority is hereby requested from your Honorable Board to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures (the "Policy") pursuant to Sec. 3(a)xxi thereof, a first amendment ("First Amendment") to an agreement between the County of Westchester (the "County") and Barton and Loguidice, D.P.C. for floodplain management planning to provide an analysis of the capability and feasibility for the design and implementation of a network of flood and stream gauges to function as data collection and early warning of flood events to mitigate flooding and flood damage., for a term commencing retroactively on November 1, 2023 and expiring on October 31, 2024 in an amount not-to-exceed \$35,000 (the "Agreement"). The Agreement was authorized by Short Form approval ID number 68889. The proposed First Amendment would authorize an extension of the expiration date of the Agreement from October 31, 2024 to April 30, 2025.

Ordinarily, under Section 5 of the Policy, the County is required to solicit written or oral quotations from no fewer than three persons customarily providing such services, and, if deemed appropriate, to inquire as to the qualifications and experience of such persons for the First Amendment to the Agreement. However, Barton and Loguidice, D.P.C. has been performing satisfactorily pursuant to the Agreement, and due to an unavoidable delay in the execution of the Agreement, there has not been sufficient time for the completion of the floodplain management planning. Therefore, an extension of time is required.

Pursuant to Section 3(a)xxi thereof, the Policy is not applicable to any procurement for which this Board determines, by resolution passed prior to commencing

such procurement, that compliance with the Policy would not be in the best interest of the County. For the reasons set forth above, it is proposed that the best interests of the County would be served by exempting the procurement of the First Amendment to the Agreement from the Policy.

Accordingly, a Resolution to exempt the procurement of the First Amendment to an Agreement between the County and Barton and Loguidice, D.P.C. is hereby submitted for your Honorable Board's consideration.
