SUBJECT: Authority to enter into an agreement with the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration, to accept Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Grant in the amount of \$424,715 for Capital Project Number A0118 – Runway 16/34 Rehabilitation at the Westchester County Airport (Grant No. 3-36-0123-147-2026)

Authority is respectfully requested for the County of Westchester (the “County”), acting by and through its Department of Public Works and Transportation, to enter into an agreement with the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”), to accept an Infrastructure Investment and Jobs (“IIJA”) Grant, Grant No. 3-36-0123-147-2026.

The purpose of this grant is to fund the design of the installation of the elevated runway guard lights, in-pavement runway guard lights, and runway surface condition sensor system of Runway 16/34 at the Westchester County Airport. The total estimated cost of this portion of the project is \$471,906. The FAA will fund 90% of this amount through the IIJA Grant, the New York State Department of Transportation has indicated that they will fund 5%, and the County’s 5% local share will be funded through the Airport Special Revenue Fund.

This project is part of the FAA’s Airport Capital Improvement Program, which provides entitlement-based funding linked to commercial passenger enplanements. The program supports infrastructure projects that ensure operational safety and compliance with Federal aviation regulations.

The objective of this Agreement is to accept Federal funding for a capital project that will design the installation of new elevated and in-pavement runway guard lights at the intersection of Runway 16/34 and Runway 11/29. It will also fund the design for the installation of new in-pavement runway surface condition sensor systems. The project will improve airfield safety by bringing the airport into closer alignment with FAA standards and recommendations, enhancing runway condition monitoring, strengthening runway incursion prevention measures, and improving aircraft and vehicle operations during low-visibility and winter weather conditions.

RESOLUTION

Upon communication from the Commissioner of Public Works and Transportation, be it

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester (the “County”), acting by and through its Department of Public Works and Transportation, is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with the United States of America, acting through the Federal Aviation Administration (“FAA”), to accept an Infrastructure Investment and Jobs (“IIJA”) Grant, Grant No. 3-36-0123-147-2026; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the purpose of said Grant is to fund the design of the Rehabilitation of Runway 16/34 at the Westchester County Airport; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the total estimated cost of this portion of the project is \$471,906, of which 90%, not to exceed \$424,715, will be funded by the FAA through the IIJA Grant. The New York State Department of Transportation has indicated that they will fund 5%, not to exceed \$23,595, and the remaining 5%, estimated at \$22,596 will be funded by the County through the Airport Special Revenue Fund; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is authorized to execute any instruments and to take any actions reasonably necessary to implement this Resolution.
