On October 29, 2025, the County of Westchester ("County") received and opened four (4) bids for Contract No. 23-504 for Rehabilitation of Alexander Street and Irvington Pumping Stations, North Yonkers Sanitary Sewer District, City of Yonkers and Village of Irvington, New York.

The bids were reviewed by the Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department") and it was determined that ECCO III Enterprises, Inc. submitted the low bid in the amount of \$17,214,000.00. ECCO III Enterprises, Inc. has proposed the use of the following subcontractors: Clean Aqua Quality Service, Inc. (Plumbing), 161 Brady Avenue, Hawthorne, New York 10532, Filingeri Electrical Contracting Corp. (Electrical), 3510 Lexington Avenue, Mohegan Lake, New York 10547; and Vamco Sheet Metal, Inc. (HVAC), 3090 Route 9, Cold Spring, New York 10516.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that ECCO III Enterprises, Inc.:

The objective of this contract is to replace and upgrade the County-owned sewage pumping station which suffers significant wear and tear due to constant use. The upgrade not only cover necessary replacement and rehabilitation, but also improves efficiency of the pumping stations by reducing energy and manpower costs, as well as improves the operational performance and reliability of the facilities.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it ensures that the facility meets ongoing operational needs and complies with current building codes.

The Department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 23-504 be awarded to ECCO III Enterprises, Inc. in the amount of \$17,214,000.00.
