First Amendment to Agreement No. 22-912 in the matter of Project Management Services for **SUBJECT:**

Various Building Renovation Projects

D&B Engineers and Architects, D.P.C. **Consultant:**

\$3,000,000.00 **Amendment Amount:**

The County of Westchester ("County"), acting by and through its Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department"), entered into Agreement No. 22-912 ("Original Agreement"), approved on July 28, 2022, with D&B Engineers and Architects, D.P.C. ("Consultant"), 4 West Red Oak Lane, Suite 315, White Plains, New York 10604, wherein the Consultant was to provide Project Management Services for Various Building Renovation Projects. The Original Agreement expired on August 14, 2025. The Agreement may be extended for an additional two (2) years at the sole option of the County.

Some of the project management services that are being provided pursuant to the Original Agreement, are still underway and require additional time to complete ("Remaining Work"). The Remaining Work consists of the following:(i) Repair of Primary/Final Clarifier Bridges, Ossining Water Resource Recovery Facility ("WRRF") (Work Order #1); (ii) Shoreline Restoration, Ossining WRRF (Work Order #2); (iii) Wilson's Woods Wave Pool (Work Order #3); (iv) Electric Vehicle Chargers - Michaelian Office Building, White Plains and 450 Saw Mill River Road, Ardsley (Work Order #4); (v) Mountain Lakes Camp Hemlock Mess Hall Roof (Work Order #5); (vi) Marshlands Nature Center (Work Orders #6 and #9); (vii) Peekskill District Office Window and Storefront Replacement (Work Order #7); (viii) Mountain Lakes Spruce Lake Dining Hall Roof (Work Order #8); and (ix) DEF Chemical Bulk Storage Tank Inspections (Work Order #10). In order to provide anticipated services for the remainder of the term, the Department needs to amend this Agreement for additional services and extend the term of the Agreement.

Authority of your Honorable Board is therefore requested to amend the existing Agreement between the County and the Consultant to provide for additional Project Management Services for Various Building Renovation Projects. The consultant shall provide project management services to assist Department personnel in managing the capital program and reducing the backlog of capital projects awaiting completion. For project management services, the consultant shall provide staff augmentation, develop requests for proposals, provide consultant management, develop a Project Management Plan, monitor project schedules, manage project budgets, provide project close-out services, and provide other consulting services as directed by the Commissioner of the Department.

The objective of this project will be to perform project management services for various building renovation projects. This work is necessary to augment the Department's Engineering Division staff in the preparation of capital projects, requests for proposals, and the oversight of other consultants during the study, design, and construction phases of a capital project. Projects vary in complexity and include building renovations with total budgets ranging from \$100,000 to \$10,000,000. This Agreement will benefit the public as it will provide a costeffective method to manage capital projects, thereby ensuring timely project completion within budget.

The engineering discipline encompassed in this Amendment is not new, but rather, it is an integral part of the agreement scope that involves the same degree of skill, experience and complexity as the expertise generally Board of Acquisition and Contract Agreement No. 22-912, First Amendment Project Management Services for Various Building Renovation Projects D&B Engineers and Architects, D.P.C. described in the original agreement scope. Accordingly, this type of engineering discipline was originally contemplated in the Professional Prequalification Board and Professional Selection Board process.

The Agreement fee was increased by an additional \$3,000,000.00 pursuant to an approved budget, bringing the total Agreement plus Amendment to \$6,000,000.00. The completion date of the Agreement shall be extended retroactively from August 14, 2025 until August 14, 2027.

Except as specifically amended hereby, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain the same and in full force and effect.

The Department of Public Works and Transportation will track scheduling and accomplishments by the Consultant and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project. It is recognized and understood that the County shall evaluate the performance of this Agreement by the Consultant and shall use such evaluation in deciding to award future contracts to the Consultant.

ARPROVED BOARD OF ACQUISITION & CONTRACT. I urge your favorable consideration of the annexed proposed Resolution.

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester ("County"), acting by and through its Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department"), be and is hereby authorized to amend Agreement No. 22-912, ("Agreement") with D&B Engineers and Architects, D.P.C. ("Consultant"), 4 West Red Oak Lane, Suite 315, White Plains, New York 10604, in order to provide additional Project Management Services for Various Building Renovation Projects. The Consultant shall provide project management services to assist Department personnel in managing the capital program and reducing the backlog of capital projects awaiting completion. For project management services, the Consultant shall provide staff augmentation, develop requests for proposals, provide consultant management, develop a Project Management Plan, monitor project schedules, manage project budgets, provide project close-out services, and provide other consulting services as directed by the Commissioner of the Department; and be it further

RESOLVED, that for the additional services rendered, the Consultant shall be paid a fee of \$3,000,000.00 pursuant to an approved budget, bringing the total Agreement plus Amendment to \$6,000,000.00; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the completion date of the Agreement shall be extended retroactively from August 14, 2025 until August 14, 2027; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.

RESOLVED, that all other provisions of the existing Agreement shall remain in full force and effect; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary or appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
