Re: Amending a resolution, which authorized the County of Westchester to enter into an agreement with United Behavioral Health of New York, I.P.A. Inc. for the County to provide mental/behavioral health covered services to UBHIPA members in exchange for payment at the rates attached to the resolution in order to add the term of the agreement to the resolution and budget box.

By a resolution approved on July 22, 2026 (the "July 22nd Resolution"), your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Department of Community Mental Health (the "Department"), to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement") with United Behavioral Health of New York, I.P.A. Inc. ("UBHIPA") for the County, through the Westchester County Safety Net Clinic, to provide covered services to UBHIPA members enrolled in the networks of the participating providers developed and designated by UBHIP and accept as payment in full for such covered services the rates attached to the July 22nd Resolution.

Due to an oversight, the term of the Agreement, which was included in the cover memo, was not carried over to the resolution or included the budget box for the resolution.

The term of the Agreement shall commence on the date specified in the UBHIPA executed Acceptance Letter ("Effective Date") and shall remain in effect for an initial term of 12 months from the Effective Date and shall automatically renew for successive 1-year terms until it is terminated.

Also, in the Agreement, each party shall have the right to terminate the Agreement without cause on 60 days prior written notice to the other party.

Also, in the Agreement, each party shall have the right to elect to not renew the Agreement each January first occurring after the Agreement has been in effect for at least one year upon 60 days notice to the other party.

In order to correct the aforementioned oversight, it will be necessary to amend the July 22nd Resolution.

Accordingly, attached hereto is a resolution amending the July 22nd Resolution to add the following decretal paragraphs:

RESOLVED, that the term of the Agreement shall commence upon the date specified in the UBHIPA executed Acceptance Letter (“Effective Date”) and shall remain in effect for an initial term of 12 months from the Effective Date and shall automatically renew for successive 1-year terms until it is terminated, and be it further

RESOLVED, that each party shall have the right to terminate the Agreement, without cause on 60 days prior written notice to the other party; and be it further

RESOLVED, that each party shall have the right to elect to not renew the Agreement each January first occurring after the Agreement has been in effect for at least one year upon 60 days notice to the other party; and be it further

The attached resolution also amends the July 22nd Resolution to delete the budget and replace it with the following:
