Authority for the County of Westchester, acting on behalf of the SUBJECT:

Westchester-Putnam Local Workforce Development Board, to amend a

resolution approved on December 14, 2023 (the "December 14th

Resolution") which authorized the County to enter into an agreement with each of the sixty-six (66) training providers listed in the December 14th Resolution, pursuant to which each provider would provide vocational training services to adult, dislocated workers, and youth pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 for the period from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2027, for a total aggregate amount not-to-exceed \$857,901, by 1) adding six (6) new training providers to the list set forth in the December 14th Resolution; 2) Increasing the aggregate not-to-exceed amount by \$1,267,803 to a new aggregate not-to-exceed amount of \$2,125,704; 3) rescinding 50 training

providers from the list set forth in the December 14th Resolution; and 4) correcting the vendor name of one of the providers on the list set forth in

the December 14th Resolution.

By resolution approved on December 14, 2023, your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester, acting on behalf of the Westchester-Putnam Local Workforce Development Board, (the "County") to enter into an agreement with each of the sixty-six (66) training providers listed in the December 14th Resolution, pursuant to which each provider would provide vocational training services to adult, dislocated workers, and youth pursuant to the provisions of Title I of the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 ("WIOA"), for the period from July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2027, for a total aggregate amount not-to-exceed \$857,901.

Six (6) new organizations, as listed below, have requested approval to serve as WIOA Eligible Training Providers. These vendors have registered on both the New York State Training Provider Website and on the One Stop site and were selected based upon their expertise and experience in providing the necessary training services.

Accordingly, authority is respectfully requested to amend the December 14th Resolution, in order to add the six (6) new training providers listed below to the list of training providers set forth in the December 14th Resolution:
