The 2024 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for replacement and/or upgrade of the primary electric service to the Port Chester plant including the MCC and emergency back-up power equipment, as well as interior alterations needed for the new MCC equipment; upgrades to all the HVAC system equipment and odor control ductwork including gas detection and fire alarm systems. In addition, included will be the relocation of the existing maintenance shop and ceiling replacement in the existing control building; the construction of a new powerhouse building, the replacement of the existing sludge processing, administration and primary settling tank building roofs, as well as the six (6) remaining various building roofs.

In accordance with Chapter 633 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this project is to upgrade the electrical system of the plant, most of which was installed in 1987, because the typical life span of electrical distribution equipment is about 20 to 30 years, and as such the system has reached the end of its useful life. The heating, ventilating and air conditioning (HVAC) systems and odor control system ductwork at the Port Chester WWTP, as well as the Admin. and Sludge Processing Building roofs, are all also approaching the end of their useful Me. All these important systems and components should be replaced or upgraded in order to maintain reliability, safety and ease of maintenance.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it ensures that the facility meets ongoing operational needs and complies with current building codes.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
