- RAYMOND SCULK SECRETARY Authority for the County of Westchester, acting by and through Re: Westchester Community College, to enter into an agreement with the Yonkers Public Schools, acting by and through its Board of Education, to provide the School District's students with first aid and CPR certification for the period from January 1, 2025 through August 31, 2025 whereby the College shall be paid an amount not-to-exceed \$8,778.15.

Westchester Community College (the "College") and The Yonkers Public Schools, acting by anothrough its Board of Education (the "Yonkers Public Schools"), have collaborated on a number of programs over the years that have benefited both students and instructors from the Yonkers Public Schools.

Authority is now requested to authorize the County of Westchester (the "County", acting by and through the College, to enter into an agreement with the Yonkers Public Schools, whereby the College shall provide the Yonkers Public School's students with first aid and CPR certification (the "Services"), so as to equip them with essential skills for their future academic and career pursuits. The proposed agreement will have a term commencing retroactive to January 1, 2025 and will continue through August 31, 2025. In consideration for Services rendered, the Yonkers Public Schools will pay to the College an amount not-toexceed EIGHT THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT and 15/100 DOLLARS (\$8,778.15).

Pursuant to the terms of the proposed Agreement, the College is required to agree that except for the amount, if any, of damage contributed to, caused by, or resulting from the negligence of the School District and/or City, the College shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the School District and the City, and

their respective officers, employees, agents and elected and appointed officials from and against any and all liability, damage, claims, demands, costs, judgments, fees, reasonable attorney's fees or loss (including but not limited to personal injury and death) to the extent arising directly or indirectly out of the willful misconduct or negligent performance or failure to perform hereunder by the College or third parties under its direction or control, including without limitation, any claim that a deliverable infringes upon an intellectual property right. If such an intellectual property infringement claim is made, or appears likely to be made, the Consultant agrees to enable the School District's continued use of the deliverable, or to modify or replace it; and (b) to provide defense for and defend, at its sole expense, any and all claims, demands or causes of action directly or indirectly arising out of this Agreement and to bear all other costs and expenses related thereto.

This Agreement is exempt from the operation of the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3(a)(iii) in that it is an agreement with a political subdivision of the State of New York. The Agreement is authorized pursuant to Section 6306.8 of the Education Lawin that it is an agreement for a cooperative educational program with a school district. This is not a service that the School District could have performed for itself and therefore does not require Board of Legislators approval.

Upon a communication from the President of Westchester Community College, be it hereby:

RESOLVED, that the County of Westchester, acting by and through Westchester Community College (the "College"), is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Yonkers Public Schools, acting by and through its Board of Education, whereby the College shall provide Yonkers Public School's students with first aid and CPR certification (the "Services"), so as to equip them with essential skills for their future academic and career pursuits, for a term commencing retroactive to January 1, 2025 and continuing through August 31, 2025 (the "Agreement"); and be it further

RESOLVED, that in consideration for Services rendered, the Yonkers Public Schools will pay to the College an amount not-to-exceed EIGHT THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT and 15/100 DOLLARS (\$8,778.15); and be it further

RESOLVED, that pursuant to the terms of the proposed Agreement, the College will agree that except for the amount, if any, of damage contributed to, caused by, or resulting from the negligence of the School District and/or City, the College shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the School District and the Gity, and their respective officers, employees, agents and elected and appointed officials from and against any and all liability, damage, claims, demands, costs, judgments, fees, reasonable attorney's fees or loss (including but not limited to personal injury and death) to the extent arising directly or indirectly out of the willful misconduct or negligent performance or failure to perform hereunder by the College or third parties under it direction or control, including without limitation, any claim that a deliverable infringes upon an intellectual property right.
