The 2025 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for the rehabilitation of the Alexander Street and Irvington Pumping Stations in the North Yonkers Sanitary Sewer District in the City of Yonkers and Village of Irvington, New York. The work under this contract will include, but not be limited to, rehabilitation or replacement of major mechanical equipment and systems including sewage pumps, motors, drives, piping and valves, gas and fire detection systems, instrumentation, HVAC, odor control equipment, structural and architectural systems, lighting, electrical conduit and wire, electrical distribution equipment and panels, floors, walls, windows, roof, bar screens, emergency generator (Irvington PS) and security systems as well as installation of flood hazard mitigation measures, from a previous study.

In accordance with Chapter 635 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Department of Public Works and Transportation has evaluated the needs of this project and determined that a Project Labor Agreement (PLA) will benefit and enhance the interests of the County in the timely and efficient completion of the project. The Contractor to whom this contract is awarded will be required to execute a PLA.

The objective of this project is to replace and upgrade the County owned sewage pumping station which suffers significant wear and tear due to constant use. The upgrades not only cover necessary replacement and rehabilitation, but also improves efficiency of the pumping stations by reducing energy and manpower costs, as well as improves the operational performance and reliability of the facilities.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it ensures that the facility meets ongoing operational needs and complies with current building codes.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
