The 2025 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

This contract includes all of the labor, materials, and equipment necessary to replace the controls for the existing high-pressure steam boilers and deaerators with standardized instrumentation. The project includes the demolition of existing control panels, installation of new control panels and work station, as well as associated work.

The objective of this project is to replace the current obsolete control instrumentation updated equipment.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it ensures the continued functionality and increased efficiency of the boilers and deaerators at the Grasslands Campus' Central Heating Plant.

The Department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further
