On December 18, 2024, the County of Westchester ("County") received and opened two (2) bids for Contract No. 24-504 Interim and Long-Term Bio-Solids Handling and Processing, Blind Brook Water Resource Recovery Facility, Rye, New York.

Two (2) contractors submitted a bid for this project. The project was advertised on the Empire State Purchasing Group website, in addition to the Journal News (Westchester-Putnam Edition), and was viewed by ninety-five (95) entities on the Empire State Purchasing Group website. In addition, e-mails were sent to those ninety-five (95) entities and to an additional one thousand four hundred and five (1,405) suppliers and contractors.

The bids were reviewed by the Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department") and it was determined that Mace Contracting Corporation (MBE) submitted the low bid in the amount of \$566,350.00.

The low bidder has been investigated and it has been found that Mace Contracting Corporation (MBE):

Performed satisfactory work in the past for the County.
 Past Experience found satisfactory.

The objective of this contract is to inspect and rehabilitate or replace the 8-inch forcemain as well as provide sludge storage facilities at the Blind Brook WRRF. This will provide for increased efficiency and reliability of sludge transfer and pumping to the Port Chester WRRF and prevent future violations of the treatment plant's State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("SPDES") Permit.

This contract is in the public's best interest because it ensures that the facility meets ongoing operational needs and complies with current building codes.

The Department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.

It is my recommendation that Contract No. 24-504 be awarded to Mace Contracting Corporation (MBE) in the amount of \$566,350.00.
