Re: Resolution to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures, pursuant to Section 3(a)(xxi) thereof, the procurement of an agreement with DLL Finance LLC, through its subcontractor Club Car, LLC, for the provision and maintenance of 29 new GPS-equipped golf carts for a term of April 1, 2026 through December 31, 2027.

Authority is hereby requested from your Honorable Board to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures the procurement of a lease agreement (the "Agreement") between the County of Westchester (the "County") and DLL Finance LLC (the "DLL") for the provision and maintenance of 29 new GPS-equipped golf carts for a term of April 1, 2026 through December 31, 2027 on behalf of the County's Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation (the "Department") for use at County golf courses.

Pursuant to the Agreement, DLL shall provide golf cars, golf car maintenance and related services and equipment during the term of the Agreement for use at County golf courses. It should be noted by your Honorable Board, that the golf carts, maintenance and related services and equipment shall be provided by DLL through a County approved subcontractor, Club Car, LLC ("Car Club"), but that the County shall enter into an Agreement directly with Club Car's financing company, DLL.

Ordinarily, under Section 6 of the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures, the County is required to solicit such services through the issuance of a Request for Proposals. However, DLL and Club Car have over ten (10) years of experience providing quick and efficient golf car leasing and maintenance services to the County. In addition, the County already has an existing agreement with DLL (with Club Car as an approved subcontractor) to provide the County with the provision of golf carts, including GPS and

maintenance services. As such, and based on the existing arrangement with DLL to supply golf carts to the County golf courses, and the higher price that the County would need to pay to lease a limited number of additional carts from another vendor, it would neither be cost effective nor expedient to separately procure this golf cart lease and maintenance agreement.

This agreement will be for 29 additional carts at the following courses:

Mohansic Golf Course – 10 gasoline powered golf carts

Sprain Lake Golf Course – 10 gasoline powered golf carts

Maple Moor Golf Course – 4 gasoline powered golf carts

Saxon Woods Golf Course -5 gasoline powered golf carts

Pursuant to Section 3(a) xxi of the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures, the Procurement Policy and Procedures are not applicable to any procurement for which this Honorable Board determines, by resolution passed prior to commencing such procurement, that compliance with the Procurement Policy and Procedures would not be in the best interests of the County. For the reasons set forth above, it is proposed that the best interests of the County would be served by exempting this agreement from the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures. A resolution to exempt the Agreement with DLL from Procurement Policy is hereby submitted for your consideration.
