SCULKY, SECRETARY Resolution authorizing an Agreement between the County of Westchester. SUBJECT:

56 Linden Ave, LLC. and WPS Contracting Group, LLC. for the

rehabilitation of the property located at 56 Linden Ave, Ossining, New

York.

The attached resolution, if approved by your Honorable Board, would authorize the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into an agreement with WPS Contracting Group, LLC. (the "Contractor") and 56 Linder Ave, LLC. (the "Property Owner"), pursuant to which the Contractor will make repairs to 56 Linden Ave, in Ossining (the "Property") through the Lead Safe Westchester ("LSW") Program, which is a program designed to reduce lead-based paint razards. In consideration for services rendered. the County will pay the Contractor an amount not to exceed \$45,479, pursuant to an approved budget. The term of the agreement is May 15, 2025 to May 14, 2026.

The LSW Program will finance repairs completed by an EPA Certified Contractor to stabilize deteriorated lead-based paint at the Property identified in a lead inspection/risk assessment as well as areas cited in a Department of Health ("DOH") violation in response to a childin residence with an elevated blood lead level.

The goal and objective of this agreement is to provide a safe and healthy environment for the residents of this Property. The project will be monitored by Department of Planning staff who will make site visits during the construction to ensure all contractual obligations are met.

In accordance with Section 5 of the County's Procurement Policy and Procedures, an RFP for the services described above was posted on the County's website. The Department of Planning staff also sent emails announcing the RFP specifications to a list of EPA Certified Lead Contractors as potential proposers. Three (3) proposals were submitted (AltaVista Lead Improvement, Inc., WPS Contracting Group, LLC. and El Dorado Renovations, Inc.). After a review of the price proposals, this project was awarded to WPS Contracting Group, LLC, which submitted the lowest price proposal.

On January 12, 2023, the Board of Acquisition and Contract approved a resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to enter into a grant agreement with the United States Department of Housing & Urban Development, Office of Lead Hazard Control and Healthy Homes for an amount totaling \$4,100,000.00 to reduce lead-based paint hazards in Westchester County.

I recommend approval of this agreement.

RESOLVED, that the work will include, but not be limited to, repairing deteriorated areas identified in a lead inspection (risk assessment as well as areas cited in a Westchester County Department of Health ("DOH") violation in response to a child in residence with an elevated blood lead level; and be it further

RESOLVED: that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is authorized to execute any documents and take any actions necessary to effectuate the purposes hereof.
