Attached for your consideration is a resolution which, if approved by your Honorable Board, would authorize settlement of the last of the three claims in the lawsuit entitled, Phyllis A. Alston, Maureen E. Daprile, and Nicole Williams v. County of Westchester, et al v. The County of Westchester, et al, Index No. 70866/2018. This last claim is that of Nicole Williams. The claims of Alston and Daprile have been previously settled and paid by the County.

The matter tentatively settled on October 28, 2024 pending this Board's approval of a settlement in the amount of \$750,000, inclusive of attorney's fees. County's insurance company, RLI Insurance Company, agreed to settle this matter for a total of \$1.5 million by assuming a 50% share - - \$750,000. - - of this settlement with the insurer for co-defendant Leprechaun Bus Lines also paying \$750,000. The County will only pay the \$97,624.87, remaining balance of its \$250,000 self-insured retention in its \$1 million insurance policy with RLI Insurance Company.

The circumstances of this Liberty Lines bus incident case are as follows:

The accident occurred at about 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, 5/24/18. The place of the accident was the oval in front of Westchester Medical Center in Valhalla at South Plaza Road and Emergency Drive. Plaintiff was a passenger on a bus owned by Leprechaun Lines, Inc., which was involved in a left-sided sideswipe interaction with a Liberty Lines bus. Plaintiff claimed various injuries as a result of the accident.

On 5/3/22, an orthopedic surgeon performed a lumbar lammectomy, partial facetectomy, and foraminotomy at L4-5 on plaintiff's back. On 4/9/19, plaintiff underwent a cervical discectomy and fusion at C4-5 and C5-6.

Plaintiff was awarded partial summary judgment by order dated and entered March 14, 2022. It is important to note that the plaintiff won a motion for summary judgment on the issue of liability. Consequently, the risk of unsuccessfully defending this case during a trial increased significantly.

The bus operator involved in this accident was given retraining and issued a special agreement for the accident.

The settlement takes into consideration the uncertainty of litigation and the potential costs of trial, subsequent proceedings and potential appeal. Both outside counsel and our insurer's adjuster recommend this settlement. The County will pay the \$97,624.87. balance of the \$250,000 self-insured retention in its insurance policy.

County of Westchester, et al.</u> Index No. 70866/2018 by payment from the County of Westchester to Nicole Williams in an amount not to exceed \$97,624.87; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the County Attorney or his designee is authorized to execute any documents necessary to implement this resolution.
