3ND SCULKY, SECRETARY Authority to enter into an agreement with Brewster Central School District Re: wherein Westchester Community College will provide advisory services & resources in furtherance of the development of the P-Tech program that will prepare District students for high-skilled jobs in technology & manufacturing, for the period from September 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, at a fee not to exceed \$23,943.30

Authority is hereby requested for the County of Westchester, acting by and through Westchester Community College (the "College") to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement") with the Brewster Central School District (""District"), pursuant to which the College will provide advisory services & resources in furtherance of the development of the P-Tech program that will prepare District students for high-skilled jobs in technology & manufacturing, for the period from September 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, for a fee not to exceed \$23,943.30. The District does not have the resources or skills to provide these services.

Pursuant to the terms of the proposed Agreement, the College will be required to agree, in a form similar to the following: to indemnify, defend and hold the District harmless from and against any and all claims, suits, actions, causes of action. damages, judgments, liabilities, fines, penalties, and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees and litigation costs arising out of the indemnifying party's intentional or regligent acts or omissions.

As this Agreement does not involve the procurement of goods or services, it is not subject to the provisions of the Westchester County Procurement Policy.

It is in the best interest of the College to offer these services to encourage cooperation between local school districts and the College and possibly serve as an avenue for more students to attend Westchester Community College.

Accordingly, I recommend adoption of the attached resolution.
