SUBJECT: Amending an agreement with My Sisters' Place, Inc., for the provision of its 'R.E.A.L.' program, for the period from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2028, in order to change three (3) of the four (4) authorized locations for the program.

By a resolution approved on February 12, 2026, your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester ("County") to, among other things, enter into an agreement with My Sisters' Place, Inc. ("MSP"), pursuant to which MSP was to provide its 'R.E.A.L.' program (the "Program"), at four (4) specified sites, for the period from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2028, for an amount not-to-exceed \$150,000.00 in County funds, with a match of \$16,668.00 from MSP (the "Agreement"). The Agreement was subsequently executed.

MSP has informed the County that it desires to change three (3) of the four (4) originally-intended location for the Program. Therefore, MSP is seeking County consent to amend the Agreement in order to change three (3) of the four (4) authorized locations for the Program, to serve the same targeted youth population.

The County is agreeable to changing the sites at issue for the Program. Therefore, the County is seeking authority from your Honorable Board to amend the Agreement by authorizing a change in the locations for the Program (the "First Amendment").

Except as specifically described above, all terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain in full force and effect.

The proposed First Amendment will serve a public purpose by ensuring that the currently-intended sites for the Program are properly documented and authorized in the Agreement.

The goal and objective of the proposed First Amendment is in the best interests of the County in terms of public health and welfare, as ensuring that the currently-intended sites for the Program are properly documented and authorized in the Agreement is intended to advance the health and welfare of the targeted youth population by making certain that the Program can operate at MSP's specified sites.

The goal and objective of the proposed First Amendment will be tracked and monitored by the staff of the County's Youth Bureau.
