Re: Resolution to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy pursuant to Section 3(a)(xxi) thereof, the procurement of an agreement with Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute to outline the expectations, engagement periods, deliverables, and costs for the collaboration with the County to enhance technical ability and workforce development in Westchester County, for a term from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, for an amount not-to-exceed \$500,000.00, payable pursuant to an approved budget.

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Authority of your Honorable Board is requested to exempt from the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures (“Procurement Policy”) the procurement of an agreement with Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (“RPI”) to outline the expectations, engagement periods, deliverables, and costs for the collaboration with the County to enhance technical ability and workforce development in Westchester County, for a term from January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, for an amount not-to-exceed \$500,000.00, payable pursuant to an approved budget.

Under this agreement, RPI will: execute a marketing plan; build and begin delivery of an undergraduate Bachelor of Technology in Production and Operations Management; undertake an RPI engineering undergraduate degree/program feasibility study for an engineering-focused program to be delivered in Westchester; track and report progress on initiatives to appropriate County representatives; and collaborate with the County to continue building ProCourses that meet Westchester employer needs. The County will: secure and disburse funding to RPI upon execution of the agreement; collaborate in marketing and public relations initiatives; include RPI in Westchester industry groups, events, and employer relationships, as appropriate; and assist, as needed, in identifying a physical location for the Assistant Dean for Strategic Partnerships in a location that optimizes relationship development with all Westchester stakeholders.

Pursuant to Section 3(a)(xxi), the Procurement Policy is not applicable to any procurement for which your Honorable Board determines, by Resolution passed prior to commencing such procurement, that compliance with the policy would not be in the best interest of the County. It is proposed that the County’s interest would be served by exempting the procurement of this

agreement from the County Procurement Policy. A Resolution to exempt the procurement of this agreement is submitted for your consideration.

As I believe this agreement to be in the best interests of the County, I most respectfully recommend and urge the adoption of the annexed Resolution.
