and the Town of New Castle for Interior and Exterior Upgrades to the

Town's Senior Center.

The attached resolution, if approved by your Hororable Board, wouldofm authorize an agreement between the County of Westchester (the "County") and the Town of New Castle (the "Town") for interior and exterior upgrades to the Town's Senior Center, located in New Castle (the "Project"). Under this agreement, the Town will fix water damage at the foundation and subsurface levels of the building. The County will provide the Town with up to \$125,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, based on an approved budget, to carry out the Project. The agreement will be from September 15, 2025 to September 14, 2026.

The Project will include but not be limited to waterproofing and structural work to solve ongoing water issues at the base of the building. These improvements will create a safer, healthier and more comfortable space for the community, especially to its senior residents. The upgraded facility will also serve as an emergency shelter and a central hub for community services, such as the New Castle Meals on Wheels Program.

The Towe's Department of Public Works and staff from the Westchester County Department of Planning will monitor the Project by conducting site visits to ensure all contractual requirements are met.

This procurement of this Agreement is exempt from the County of Westchester Procurement Policy and Procedures pursuant Section 3(a)(xvi) thereof, which exempts contracts that distribute grants or loans under the Community Development Block Grant Program.

Act # 56-2023, adopted May 4, 2023, by the Westchester County Board of Legislators, authorizes the County to submit an Urban County Application under the Federal Community Development Block Grant, Emergency Solutions Grant, and HOME

Investment Programs, amending the FY 2019-2023 Consolidated Plan to include the FY 2023 Action Plan.
