In substitution thereof, an annual renewable performance and payment bond may be furnished, in an amount equal to that year's contract amount in a form approved by the County Attorney, so long as an annual bond remains in place uninterrupted, for the duration of the contract. The Bond Underwriter or Surety must appear on the U.S. Treasury's listing of approved sureties (Department Circular 570) and all Sureties must be licensed to transact business in New York as a surety company; and be it further
