The 2024 Capital Budget contains funds for the above referenced project.

The work under this contract consists of providing all necessary labor, material and equipment required for the replacement of the biological nitrogen removal integrated fixed film activated sludge (BNR IFAS) media and the mixers in the aeration tanks at the Mamaroneck Water Resource Recovery Facility. Modifications to the aeration tank walls and sieves will also be conducted under this project. Work will include all mechanical, electrical, controls, structural, and other appurtenances as necessary.

The BNR IFAS media has experienced irreparable damage and needs to be replaced. The damage is jeopardizing the Department's ability to meet the EPA mandated nitrogen removal requirements. The mixers have reached the end of their useful life and more efficient mixers are available. The Department is required to keep its water and wastewater treatment equipment in a state of good repair, in accordance with State and Federal regulations.

The department will track scheduling and accomplishments by the contractor and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project.
