- Resolution authorizing the County of Westchester to amend a resolution SUBJECT: approved on December 12, 2024, which authorized the County to enter into agreements with seven (7) licensed consultants to provide various psychological testing and evaluations to underinsured parents and children, as well as vulnerable ad at for the period from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, for an amount not to exceed \$330,000, in order to increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$20,000, to a new total amount not to exceed \$350,000.

By resolution approved m December 12, 2024 (the "December 12th Resolution"), your Honorable Board authorized the County of Westchester, acting by and through its Department of Social Services, to enter into agreements with seven (7) licensed consultants (the "Consultants") as listed in Schedule "A", attached to the December 12th Resolution, to provide psychological testing and evaluations, psychiatric evaluations, sibling consults, fire setting evaluations, safety assessments, court ordered psychotherapy, functional capacity assessments to uninsured or underinsured parents and children as well as vulnerable adults upon referration the Department's Child Protective Services, Preventive Services, Foster Care Services as well as Protective Services for Adults Programs to be paid at rates listed in Schedule "B", attached to the December 12th Resolution, for the period from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025 in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$330,000, pursuant to an approved budget; and be it further. The Agreements have not yet been executed.

Due to administrative error, the Department now seeks authority of your Honorable Board to amend the December 12th Resolution for the limited purpose of increasing the notto-exceed amount by \$20,000, from \$330,000, to a new total amount not to exceed \$350,000.

Except as specifically amended hereby, all other terms and conditions set forth in the December 12th Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

An appropriate resolution requesting your Honorable Board's approval is attached herewith.
