Re: Resolution to exempt from the requirements of the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures a first amendment to an agreement with Greenberg Traurig LLP for legislative and executive lobbying in connection with its relations with the government of the State of New York, for a term from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025 for a total amount not to exceed \$35,000.00 to increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$25,000 to a new total aggregate amount not to exceed \$60,000.

It is proposed that the County of Westchester ("County") enter into a first amendment ("First Amendment") to its agreement with Greenberg Traurig LLP ("Greenberg Traurig") pursuant to which Greenberg Traurig provides lobbying in connection with its relations with the government of the State of New York, for a term from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025 for a total amount not to exceed \$35,000.00. The First Amendment would increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$25,000 to a new total aggregate amount not to exceed \$60,000.

Pursuant to Section 3(a)xxi thereof, the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures are not applicable to any procurement for which your Honorable Board determines, by resolution passed prior to commencing such procurement, that compliance with the policy would not be in the best interest of the County. It is proposed that the County's interest would be served by exempting the procurement of this First Amendment from the County Procurement Policy. A resolution to exempt the procurement of this First Amendment to the Agreement with Greenberg Traurig is submitted for your consideration.

RESOLUTION

Based upon a communication from the County Executive, be it hereby

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 3(a)xxi of the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures, it is hereby determined that application of the procedural requirements contained therein, including the necessity of soliciting proposals, is neither cost effective nor expedient, and accordingly, not in the best interest of the County in connection with the procurement of a First Amendment (“First Amendment”) of an agreement with Greenberg Traurig LLP (“Greenberg Traurig”) to increase the not-to-exceed amount of the Agreement by \$25,000 to a new total aggregate amount not to exceed \$60,000 for provision of lobbying in connection with its relations with the government of the State of New York, for the term from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025.
