**SUBJECT:** Authority for the County of Westchester to amend Agreement No. 21-912, with Hudson Valley Engineering Associates, P.C., d/b/a HVEA Engineers, an WBE and DBE firm, for Engineering Services in connection with the Reconstruction of Boston Post Road Bridge over Playland Parkway (BIN 2000050), City of Rye, New York, in order to: i) expand the scope of services to provide for construction administration services associated with this project; ii) increase the not-to-exceed amount authorized thereunder by an additional amount not to exceed \$1,102,713.90, for a total aggregate amount not-to-exceed \$1,575,113.90, payable pursuant to an approved budget; and iii) extend the term of the Agreement, from December 31, 2026 through December 31, 2029.

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The County of Westchester (“County”), acting by and through its Department of Public Works and Transportation (“Department”), entered into Agreement No. 21-912 (“Agreement”) approved on May 20, 2021, with Hudson Valley Engineering Associates, P.C., d/b/a HVEA Engineers (“Consultant”), an WBE and DBE firm, 560 Route 52, Suite 201, Beacon, New York 12508, wherein the Consultant was to provide Engineering Services for the Reconstruction of Boston Post Road Bridge over Playland Parkway (BIN 2000050), City of Rye, New York. The original Agreement completion date is December 31, 2026.

The engineering services included in the original Agreement have been in progress. The County has been satisfied with the quality of services provided to date. A construction contract for this project was awarded to Laura Li Industries LLC on December 4, 2025. Construction work for this project, scheduled to begin in the Spring of 2026, includes the Reconstruction of Boston Post Road Bridge over Playland Parkway and Roadway Resurfacing of Playland Parkway. Construction Administration Services are required at this time.

Authority of your Honorable Board is respectfully requested to amend the existing Agreement between the County and the Consultant to provide for construction administration services in connection with the Reconstruction of Boston Post Road Bridge over Playland Parkway (BIN 2000050), City of Rye, New York and extend the term of the Agreement, from December 31, 2026 through December 31, 2029. The Consultant shall provide construction administration services associated with this project. For construction administration services, the Consultant shall monitor the construction procedures on the site to ensure compliance with the contract documents, coordinate scheduled activities of the contractors, submit construction progress reports and review and process contractors’ applications for payment.

The objective of this project will be to reconstruct Boston Post Road Bridge over Playland Parkway (BIN 2000050). This work is necessary due to deterioration of the bridge. The existing bridge was built in 1941 and has an annual average daily traffic count (“AADT”) of 10,300. It is a single span concrete arch bridge approximately 60 feet long by 70 feet wide. This bridge has a condition rating of 4.50 and requires reconstruction to ensure that it can remain a key component of the County’s infrastructure, vital to the City of Rye. This rating system, using a scale of 1 (“hazardous”) through 7 (“new”), is a weighted average of the condition of an evaluated bridge. A rating below 5 indicates that a bridge requires work and delay of this work shall result in the continued deterioration of the bridge.

The reconstruction work shall include, but not be limited to, the following items: removal and replacement of the existing asphalt wearing surface, excavation and backfill, waterproofing top of the arch, stone masonry repointing, slab and parapet wall repair, and new pavement markings. This Agreement will benefit the public as it will enhance the functionality of the bridge structure and roadway ensuring its safe use by the traveling public.

The Department of Public Works and Transportation will track scheduling and accomplishments by the Consultant and perform on-site inspections to ensure the successful completion of this project. It is recognized and understood that the County shall evaluate the performance of this contract by the Consultant and shall use such evaluation in deciding to award future contracts to the Consultant.

I urge your favorable consideration of the annexed proposed Resolution.

The Consultant shall provide construction administration services associated with this project. For construction administration services, the Consultant shall monitor the construction procedures on the site to ensure compliance with the contract documents, coordinate scheduled activities of the contractors, submit construction progress reports and review and process contractors’ applications for payment; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that for the additional services rendered, the Consultant shall be paid a fee of \$1,102,713.90 pursuant to an approved budget, increasing the total maximum fee to \$1,575,113.90; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the completion date of the Agreement shall be extended from December 31, 2026 until December 31, 2029.

**RESOLVED**, that all other provisions of the existing Agreement shall remain in full force and effect; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any and all documents necessary and appropriate to effectuate the purposes hereof.
