NOTEWORTHY EVENTS IN MOUNT KISCO DURING THE MONTH OF APRIL

• 04/04/2022 and 04/05/2022 – Case#801-22 and Case#825-22 – Two retail locations in Mount Kisco experienced larcenies where the suspects grabbed items and immediately fled the store. Investigation pending.
• 04/11/2022 – Case#905-22 – The Mount Kisco Village Manager reported that he observed graffiti on the sidewalk located by the Mount Kisco Library. The graffiti was in blue spray paint and stated "NO CELL TOWER". Video surveillance captured the incident and yielded a suspect described as a White Female in her 60s. Investigation pending.
 Coordinating and planning underway with the Village Manager's office for the call box and signage to be moved to the police entrance and video camera's installed.
• 11PCT Community Resource Officer (CRO) and Com. Policing Unit, coordinating with Village officials on a community safety and crime prevention campaign through the summer. A "slow the roll" traffic safety outreach and enforcement initiative is planned for May in an effort to reduce speeding throughout the Village.
• 11PCT CRO met with the Village Court and Judges regarding the implementation of an Amnesty Day, and a community service program option for adjudication. PO Ramirez established a weekly day laborer meeting at the library, an intern program with Fox Lane High School's ASPIRE program, coordinated a "Coffee with a Cop" event for senior citizens at Pinecrest Manor, coordinated a BBQ for youth at Pinecrest Manor with 11PCT officers, organized a community clean up day of the trail system and participated in the Latino Providers meeting.
• Com. Policing Unit and Com. Resource Officer coordinating with the WC Dept. of Community Mental Health to launch Mobile Crisis Response Team assigned to Mount Kisco precinct in May.
 Precinct and Community Policing Unit officers supported the Mount Kisco Little League parade detail, MKFD

Open House, Saint Francis of Assisi Easter detail, the Village's Earth Day event and "Operation Safe Stop" school

bus safety detail.
