On April 20, 2022, Ramapo PD received a report of a past domestic incident involving a firearm in our jurisdiction. The suspect reportedly threatened to return to the residence placing the victim in fear. We contacted the Village of Rye Brook PD to assist in locating the suspect who resides in their jurisdiction. It was believed that the suspect may have barricaded himself in his residence.

A number of Westchester law enforcement agencies, including yours, responded to assist. After an extensive period that spanned through the night, the home was entered by the Westchester County Police SRT but the suspect wasn't immediately located. Our detectives did obtain a search warrant of the residence and recovered a shotgun and rifle. The suspect was located by the Village of Rye Brook PD the next day and turned over to Ramapo PD.

I would like to extend our thanks to Chief Luciano, Sgt. Spinelli and the entire SRT Team, the Hostage Negotiation Team and your agency for the support in this case. Please extend my appreciation to all the members of your department who assisted.
