## **NOTEWORTHY EVENTS IN MOUNT KISCO DURING THE MONTH OF MAY**

- 05/06/2022 – Case#1274-22 – Officers responded to the basement mail room of 34 S Bedford Road for a report of a suspicious package containing an unknown white powder. ESU and HDU responded and a preliminary investigation was concluded and the white powder was determined to be cocaine. GIU also responded. Investigation Pending.
- 05/16/2022 – Case#1377-22 – The Village Mayor reported that a bench located in the Blackeby Parking Lot by the Memorial Garden Monument was damaged rendering it not functional anymore. The bench was last seen intact on Friday May 13, 2022. The value of the bench is approximately \$1,500. Investigation Pending.
- 05/21/2022 – Case#1435-22 – The Village Manager reported graffiti on rocks located on Town property by Byram Lake. The graffiti contained the names “Dominique”, “Hannah”, and “Grace” and “Welcome to Da Lake” in blue paint on several rocks. A check with Google Maps revealed that the graffiti was present 10 months ago. Investigation Pending.
- 05/21/2022 – Case#1437-22, Case#1441-22, Case#1442-22, Case#1443-22 – Several residents on Valley View Terrace, E. Hyatt Ave., Grove St., and Knowlton Ave. reported that there unlocked vehicles were rummaged through by an unknown suspect(s) during the overnight hours. There was (1) confirmed larceny from the vehicles at this time. Investigation Pending.
- 05/28/2022 – Case#1521-22 and Case#1525-22 – Officers responded to (2) Domestic Disputes resulting in (2) arrests where both Defendants were charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Child.
- 05/28/2022 – Case#1518-22 and Case#1519-22 – Officers responded to Target, 195 N. Bedford Road, for Larceny reports. The first case resulted in an arrest from a prior Larceny with the suspect being identified by Target Loss Prevention.

- V/Board Meeting presentation - Provided updates to the CRO Program on Monday, May 16th. Then handed out plaques to Cops and Cones sponsors with Sgt. Dress.
- Liberty Keystone program - Worked with Liberty Keystone teens at the Boys and Girls club to develop pamphlets for the community meeting and setting up the Police Week.
- Police Week - Did 3 consecutive days at the Boys and Girls Club for Police Week on the 18th-20th with kids from grades K-12 with police vehicles, meet and greet, and dodgeball.
- Coffee with a Cop - Coordinated Coffee with a Cop day at Bagel and Bean Café on the 19th as part of Police Week with Sgt. Dress.
- Coffee with Seniors - Continued to build relationships with seniors at Pinecrest Manor at their coffee hour on the 3rd, 17th, and the 30th.
- Neighbors Link - Met with Neighbors Link staff about community meeting and homeless population.
