RAYMOND SCULKY, SECRETARY THE Resolution to exempt from Section 3(a)xxi of the Westchester County Re:

Procurement Policy and Procedures the procurement of an Agreement

with Eric Mower & Associates, Inc. d/56a Mower.

Authority is hereby requested from your Honorable Board to exempt from Section 3(a)xxi of the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures the procurement of an agreement with Eric Mower & Associates, Inc. d/b/a Mower ("Mower") for the provision of public relations, marketing, advertising and creative services to promote tourism in Westchester County.

The County of Westchester (the "County"), acting by and through its Office of Tourism & Film ("WCOTF"), seeks to enter into an agreement with Mower for the provision of public relations, marketing, advertising and creative services to promote tourism in Westchester County, for a term commencing on January 1, 2022 and terminating on December 31, 2022. In consideration for services to be rendered, the County will pay Mower an amount not to exceed Four Hundred Ninet Thousand Dollars (\$490,000.00), payable pursuant to an approved budget and subject to County appropriations (the "Agreement").

Ordinarily, under Section 6 of the Procurement Policy, the County is required to solicit proposals for such services through the issuance of a Request for Proposals ("RFP"). However, Mower has been providing advertising, public relations and marketing services to the County for almost three (3) years now. As such, it is uniquely familiar with the County's advertising and marketing strategies and goals. By continuing its relationship with Mower, the County will be able to maximize the benefit of the work that Mower has performed thus far. Moreover, it will provide continuity for the "Beyond" campaign which launched prior to the pandemic and has since evolved into messaging that is relevant, positive and compelling for people traveling in the current environment.

Pursuant to Section 3(a)xxi, the Westchester County Procurement Policy and Procedures are not applicable to any procurement for which this Honorable Board determines, by resolution passed prior to commencing such procurement, that compliance with the policy would not be in the best interests of the County. For the reasons set forth above, it is proposed that the best interests of the County would be served by exempting the procurement of this Agreement with Mower from the County Procurement Policy.
