SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing an amendment to an agreement between the

County of Westchester and Sheltering the Homeless is our Responsibility Inc./Interfaith Council for Affordable Residences, Inc., its successors or assigns, in order to change the expiration date of the agreement from April

26, 2022 to April 26, 2024.

On April 16, 2020, your Honorable Soard approved a resolution authorizing the County of Westchester (the "County") to enter into an agreement with the Sheltering the Homeless is our Responsibility Inc./Interfaith Council for Affordable Residences, Inc. (the "Developer"), its successors or assigns (the "Agreement"), to provide a grant in the amount of \$333,245.00 from the federal HOME Investment Partnership Program (the "HOME Program"). The grant will be used to supplement the cost of the acquisition of the property and new construction of two detached affordable three-bedroom homeownership units which will affirmatively further fair housing ("AFFH") to be located at 112 North Lawn Avenue in Town of Greenburgh (the "Development"). The term of the Agreement is from April 27, 2020 through April 26, 2022. The Agreement was subsequently executed.

The parties now desire to amend the Agreement in order to change the expiration date from April 26, 2022 to April 26, 2024. The additional time is needed as the acquisition of the land and receipt of the construction permits has taken much longer than expected and the Developer will need additional time to complete the construction of the two homes, particularly given the current issues with shortages of building supplies due to the impact of COVID-19.

Except as specifically provided hereby, all remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

The goal and objective of this Agreement is to create fair and affordable housing, which is safe, secure, and energy efficient. The project will create homeownership opportunities for low and moderate-income families who may not otherwise be able to staff winpliance and the second second as contrained to the second as th afford to purchase a home in Westchester County. It will also enhance the neighborhood through its design and landscaping. Department of Planning staff will monitor and track construction of the Development, as well as monitor compliance with

RESOLVED: that except as specifically amended hereby, all the other terms and conditions of the Agreement will remain the same, and it is further

RESOLVED: that the County Executive or his duly authorized designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute any documents and take all actions necessary to effect the purposes of this resolution.
